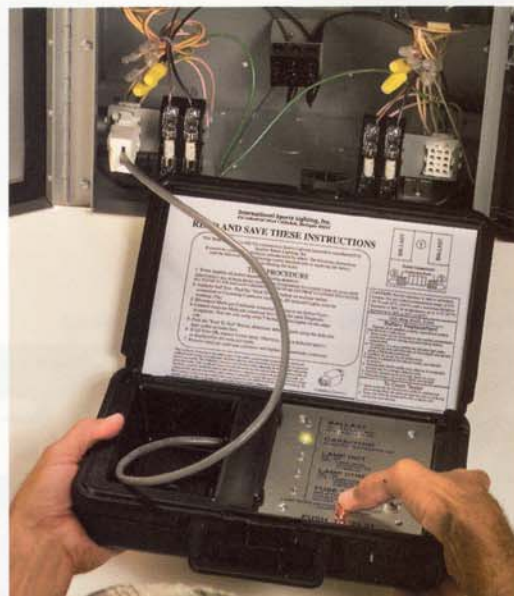

All Qualite systems now possess the receptacles as standard equipment and can be accessed by the same handheld diagnostic tester for all your fields.

Each ballast box is easily accessible with Qualite's Maintenance Diagnostic System. It utilizes a quick connect multi-pin connector to isolate and test ballast, shorted lamp condition, capacitor and fuse with all incoming power to the fixtures turned off. The use of indicator lights and instructions show all test results on the handheld diagnostic tester. The Maintenance Diagnostic System is UL listed for its intended use.
